Last time for applying for a postal vote or for changing or cancelling an existing Postal or proxy vote is not later than 5pm on Wednesday 9th July 2008. This is the same time and date for applying to register to vote for this election.

Wednesday 16th July 2008 , is the timescale for Notice of Poll and Polling Stations.

Last time for applying for a proxy vote (non emergency) is also 5pm on Wednesday 16th July 2008.

AND OF COURSE POLLING DAY IS THURSDAY 24TH JULY 2008 (7am to 10pm)

Polling stations will be announced no later than Wednesday 16th July 2008
